March 2022 Prayer Guide - Greater Cincinnati Prayer Canopy

Our focus for March is to seek the Lord in repentance and unity as we enter the Lenten season - and also to pray urgently for the people of Ukraine.

As you enter into a time of prayer for our city, take a moment to clear your thoughts and to remember that the Lord is present with you now. Spend time now quieting your own mind, thank the Lord for his many blessings. Where it is appropriate, share with the Lord those thoughts or actions that are not of him and in some way keep us from Him, turn from them and seek the Lord.

March also begins the season of Lent. This is a time in which we seek ever deeper holiness and union with God by the removing of sin, barriers that limit and inhibit our love for and experience of the Lord. As we journey towards the Easter season of resurrection let us ask for insight into the things that might keep us from loving God ever more fully and in gratitude for the Lord's mercy ask for forgiveness and strength to move in the pilgrim way of holiness. *Pause in Silence*

As you begin to pray for the intentions below, you are welcome to pray them aloud or within the silence of your own heart. It may be helpful to pray for one intention and to leave time for silence before moving on. For others a mantra of prayer, such as the Jesus Prayer, may be said between each intention, "Lord Jesus Christ, Son of God, have mercy on me, a sinner."

Scriptural guides will also be included, mostly from the Psalms, the prayer book of the Church, and may be prayed. As you pray the Word of God to the Father, recognize the presence of the Holy Spirit in this holy hour of prayer. Distractions may arise in your time of prayer but simply allow them to pass and return to your intention. You are also welcome to include your own petitions within each theme as you pray.

O Christ, our Morning Star, Splendor of Light Eternal, shining with the glory of the rainbow, come and waken us from the grayness of our apathy, and renew us in your gift of hope. -Prayer of St. Bede

O Lord in your mercy, protect the people of Ukraine and their land; strengthen Ukrainians as they defend and fight for freedom and peace for their nation... Deliver them from evil and bring many to faith.

Arts/ Media

Praise is due to you, O God of Zion... -Ps. 65:1
