Greater Cincinnati Prayer Canopy – Monthly Intercession Guide



This month's theme: Thanksgiving with personal activation.

Psalm 100:4 Enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise; give thanks to him and praise his name. 1 Thessalonians 4:16-18 Rejoice always, pray continually, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.

- Thank God for his artistry and genius in the colors and coolness of the change of season.
- Give thanks for the discipline he administers for our growth and maturity.
- Give thanks for the privilege of praying for those in suffering and persecution.
- Give thanks for his goodness in providing for our all our needs.

- Grant the grace of full hearts that overflow with gratitude for our salvation in Christ Jesus.
- Grant us a work of the Spirit to be secure and rooted in Jesus no matter our circumstances.
- Grow us in the disciplines of worship, prayer, abiding, listening, and intimacy with Jesus.
- Consecrate yourself for intercession with repentance, a fresh filling of the Spirit, and thanks.
- Then as you pray through the guide select one action step you can take to activate your prayer.

Pray for God's glory to shine in a chaotic world. Jesus has overcome!

Psalm 11:3 When the foundations are being destroyed, what can the righteous do?

- Pray for integrity in tabulating election results and peace and unity in our nation.
- Pray for wisdom in caring for refugees here, and around the globe.
- Pray that the evil of Hamas, Hezbollah and Iran would be confronted and stopped.
- Pray that the Body of Christ is salt and light as we carry the presence of Jesus wherever we go.

In the first three verses of the Psalm, David counters the fearful urgings of a friend or advisor who is ready to run away. Instead, David takes refuge in the Lord. The turning point of the Psalm is David's abiding in the temple seeking the face of the Lord. There, our man after God's heart, the man of one thing, sees that God will make things right. **Pray through Psalm 11.**

As you pray over these next sections, we challenge you to take at least one action of service to the King in November. Some examples: Ask Holy Spirit to highlight one person each week with whom to share the Gospel. Commit to serving Jesus in some new capacity. Bless a person you don't know who is clearly in need, in the name of Jesus. Pray for a particular church, ministry or pastor every day of the month. Write your activation commitments in a visible place to ensure you follow through! Share with a prayer partner for accountability!

Pray for growing love manifested in service to others.

Luke 22:27 But I am among you as one who serves.

- Pray for every believer to find their serving sweet spot, motivated by loving others.
- Pray that our entire region feels the love of Jesus through the obedience of his Body.
- Pray for greater Kingdom manifestation as the City Impact Initiative starts up.

Ask for disciple making movements.

Colossians 4:3-4 Pray that God may open a door for our message, so that we may proclaim the mystery of Christ. Pray that I may proclaim it clearly, as I should.

- Ask for boldness in sharing the Gospel to one or two people you are praying for.
- Pray against fear of man and fear of rejection.
- Pray for disciple makers from across the region to keep sowing the Gospel everywhere.
- Pray for young leaders seeking to catalyze disciple making movements in our region.
- Pray for Cincy Seed Sowers and Cincy4theGospel to find people of peace.
- Pray for Discovery Bible Studies underway to yield new multiplying churches.
- Pray that the church would stop making seedless fruit. (disciples who don't reproduce)
- Pray for the Vineyard's initiative to train and release 500 disciple makers.
- Pray that these disciple makers would make disciples who will make disciples.
- Ask the Father to bind strongholds and draw people to Jesus.

Ask for a growing passion for the gift of life.

John 10:10 The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life and have it to the full.

- Pray for every pregnant woman to desire life for the child in her womb.
- Pray that the church would welcome all children needing adoption or foster care.
- Pray that every elderly person would be respected, blessed and served in love.
- May we celebrate life from womb to tomb with joyful thanksgiving.

Ask for a Kingdom awakening.

Matthew 6:9-10 Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.

- Pray that God will raise up 7000 intercessors in each State who will pray one hour a day for revival and awakening in 2025 as the US heads into its 250th anniversary celebration in 2026.
- Pray for persecuted believers in the closed countries of the Communist and Islamic world to have great joy, to walk in the Spirit's power, and to witness disciple making movements.

- **Pray for the 2000+ disciple making movements** around the world as thousands of Buddhists, Muslims, and Hindus receive Jesus as King. **Ask for more laborers for unreached peoples.**

- Pray for the ministry of **Beth Messiah** to flourish and draw many to Yeshua. Pray that together, we would **bless and share the Gospel with every Jewish person** in our region.

- **Pray for Matthew 25 Ministries** - ask Jesus to raise all resources needed for their new facility.

- **Pray for Master Provisions** as they raise funds for expanded operations. They serve 229 partner ministries in the Tri-State, feeding 60,000 people monthly.

- **Pray for People's Church** as they seek \$60M in funding for the Taft Avenue site rebuild. Thank God for the City Council's approval to rezone their seven parcels of land into one. Pray for supernatural favor with the Uptown Consortium and other strategic foundations.

- **Pray for new businesses and employment** coming from "Start-Up Cincy Week 2024". Pray for leaders of Cintrifuse, Refinery Ventures, and Oceans Programs as they support entrepreneurs.

Let's worship Jesus and pray over our region together! (6:30-8:00 pm)

Pray for the Body of Christ in our region to walk in authority.

Matthew 18:18-20 “Truly I tell you, whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven. “Again, truly I tell you that if two of you on earth agree about anything they ask for, it will be done for them by my Father in heaven. For where two or three gather in my name, there am I with them.”

Ephesians 4:11-13 So Christ himself gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the pastors and teachers, to equip his people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ.

- Pray for training and releasing of more dedicated intercessors and watchmen.
- Pray for every gifted leader to intentionally multiply their gift through equipping others.
- Pray for the elders and deacons serving in our churches to walk blamelessly before God.
- Pray for leaders in all walks of life – business, government, non-profits – for Kingdom impact.

Pray for Israel, the peace of Jerusalem, and for righteous justice.

Genesis 12:3a I will bless those who bless you, and whoever curses you I will curse.

Psalms 89:14 Righteousness and justice are the foundation of your throne; love and faithfulness go before you.

Psalms 122:6-7 Pray for the peace of Jerusalem: “May those who love you be secure. May there be peace within your walls and security within your citadels.”

- Pray for stronger international condemnation of Hamas, Hezbollah, and Iran.
- Bind the spirits of antisemitism, violence, and lawlessness in Jesus’ mighty name.
- For protection over Israeli citizens and soldiers, and innocent Palestinians.
- For the Body of Messiah in the Land to demonstrate the love and power of the Kingdom.

- Pray for the return of kidnapped Israelis, and a lasting peace with the Arab world.
- For God to raise up Palestinian leaders who will love and serve their people with integrity.
- For the LORD's shalom to rule over the hearts of all people in Israel!
- Pray for Kingdom ministries in Israel and an awakening to Yeshua as Messiah in the Land.
- Praise God for the unity between Jewish and Arab followers of Jesus – a powerful witness.
